The telecommunications market in 2024 is going through a noticeable shift. The initial excitement around 5G is fading, and while the industry is still on track to grow—potentially reaching \$1.96 trillion by 2028—the pace has slowed. What used to be a flurry of new projects and rapid innovation is now more about mergers, acquisitions, and streamlining operations. Companies are playing it safe, focusing on stability rather than big expansions. While this trend isn't entirely new, the slowdown has become much more pronounced over the past year. This isn't just a telecoms issue; similar challenges are affecting white-collar industries across the board, with businesses balancing their growth ambitions against economic realities.

One major impact of this shift is on recruitment. While skilled professionals are still in demand, fewer new jobs are being created, and a wave of redundancies has added more candidates to the market. This has made competition for roles tougher, giving employers more freedom to focus on hiring for only the most critical positions.

Salaries are also feeling the effect. Technical and strategic roles are still well-paid, but mid-level positions are facing pressure. What used to be a candidate-driven market, with rising salaries and abundant opportunities, is now swinging back in favour of employers. With more candidates entering the job market for mid-level roles, companies have more choice and can set salary expectations to fit their budgets.

To help both professionals and businesses understand this evolving landscape, we've analysed salaries for 40 key roles in the UK across telecoms and other white-collar sectors. This report offers a straightforward look at the current pay trends and what to expect in a more competitive job market.



Sector-Specific Insights

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1. Project Management

Mixed performance with salary decreases for higher roles such as Programme Manager and Project Manager, while Project Admin saw a modest rise (+3.3%).

Project Directors remained stable with a marginal decline (-1.2%).

2. Health & Safety

Significant increases across the board, especially for Health & Safety Advisor and Manager, reflecting heightened importance of compliance and workplace safety.

Head of HSEQ saw a steady rise of 4.8%.

3. Marketing

A decline in junior and mid-level roles:

Marketing Assistant (-9.6%) and Marketing Manager (-6%).

Executive roles like Head of Marketing showed stability (+1.7%), indicating a focus on retaining senior expertise.

4. Sales

Polarisation within the sector:

Sales Advisor (+10.3%) and Head of Sales (+2.3%) experienced increases.

Sales Manager declined significantly, suggesting cost-cutting at mid-management levels.

5. Finance

Steady increases, reflecting resilience in financial roles:

Assistant Accountant (+4.3%), Finance Manager (+3.8%), and Finance Director (+1.4%).

6. Engineering & Construction

Strong growth in telecommunications and fibre roles:

Fibre Engineer saw a dramatic 35% increase, likely tied to infrastructure investments.

Civils Supervisor (+10%) and Lead Rigger (+2.6%) also demonstrated significant gains.

Traditional construction roles like Quantity Surveyor (+3.5%) and Land Surveyor (+3.8%) remained steady.

7. Human Resources

A growing emphasis on talent management led to marked increases:

Talent Acquisition Advisor (+7.7%) and HR Advisor (+14.2%).
