Fished swimbaits shallow and went through a few limits of 3lbbers each day.

Day One: Having never fished Boardman in the middle of July I didn't have a good idea what was going on. My first thought was deeper water, more than ten feet. WRONG those spots didn't work for us. They were shallow - less than ten to five feet. I believe that they were still spawning. Caught males with their sides all sore. My bait of choice Keiteck Easy Shiner 4 inch, color didn't seem to matter. Tony used a small shallow diver less than five feet. We basically fished shallow Flats with sparse weeds. Big Fish came on a drop shot 3 inch Yum Dinger Pearl nose hook. Day Two: A lot tougher, tried new water to the West. Not a good move. Back to shallow Flats with weeds. Was a slow bite for nice fish. Could not get a 3-pounder. Swimbaits best.
