1st Place: Bob Judkins & Tony Del'Arciprete - 14 lb 05 oz

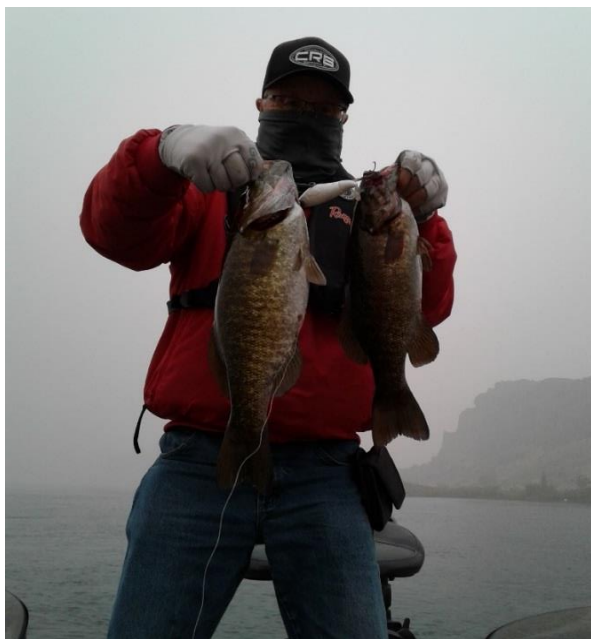
One strange day- lots of smoke. If you were in the middle of the river in some places it was hard to see each bank. Thank goodness for GPS mapping, more than one time it kept me going to the next spot. We started with topwater and swimbaits. Some blowups on topwater not hooking up. This happened all day. Did get a double hook up on a whopper popper 110. 4lbs plus. Goodway to fill out our limit. Dropshot was working too, but mostly pounders spitting up 1" shad smolts. First big fish 3lbs 6oz on a Dry Creek 2 1/2" snake river craw tube spitting up crawdad parts. That's what clued us in bigger fish eating crawdads. Smaller fish eating shad smolts. Tube the rest rest of the day. Second big fish on same tube.
