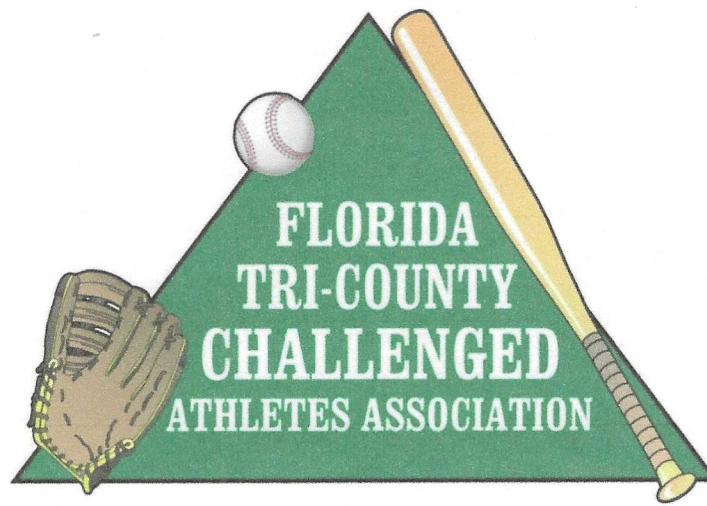




Whom It May Concern:
