The Winona County meeting will be held from 1:00-4:00p.m. on Monday, April 19 in the Winona County Assessor's office at 177 Main Street in Winona.

Shelly noted that Display Sales is having a Holiday Light sale through March 31. She will get a quote for a new pole light.

Mark approved a change to the date for a raffle that was to be held in 2020 by The Rollingstone Snowbankers group. The gambling license for a raffle was approved previously but was postponed due to COVID-19. The raffle will be held on June 25, 2021.
