



Looking after your livery Vehicle Cleaning Guidelines





- Use a fan spray of water
- Maintain nozzle more than 1200mm from livery edges
- Maximum 75 bar water pressure
- Maximum water temperature 38°C
- Maintain angle greater than 45° to the vehicle
- Use a mild detergent, clean water and soft brush
- Avoid lettering tips and corners and any obvious vulnerable areas.
- Do not direct high pressure water at edges of sheeting
- Do not hold nozzle closer than 1200mm to the livery
- Do not direct water at an angle less than 45°
- Do not use solvents, abrasive, alcohol based cleaners or vehicle under body cleaning solutions
- Do not use tar and glue/traffic film removers
- Do not steam clean liveries.
