She knew she needed a Savior.






Simon the Pharisee

He was proud of himself.


He thought his religion would get him to Heaven.


He did not think he needed a Savior. He showed Jesus no love and he had no faith.





Mary knew she was a sinner and needed forgiveness from the One true and living God of the Bible, The Lord Jesus Christ.


Jesus spoke again and said, "Your faith has saved you, go in peace!"

Won't you be like Mary and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sin? If you do, you are a child of God and Heaven is your forever home.




