

Martha believed Jesus' words.




Mary also heard Jesus was coming and ran to meet Him. She fell at the feet of Jesus.

When Jesus saw Mary weeping He wept with her.



Jesus stood by the tomb and cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!"


Though Lazarus had died, he came to life and walked out of his own tomb! Many believed in Jesus when they saw the power He had to heal even the
