

She knew she needed a Savior.








Martha was the sister of Mary

Her priorities were earthly– food for the body was most important to Martha.





Mary immediately sat at the feet of Jesus so she could learn more and more about







The Lord Jesus Christ is God in the flesh. He came to this world to seek and to save lost souls.
