Then, Mary anointed the feet of Jesus and wiped His feet with her hair. The fragrance of the expensive oil filled the room.




Judas was at dinner with Jesus and he became very angry, saying, "Why wasn't this oil sold and the money given to the poor?"


Judas didn't really care about the poor, he just wanted more money for Himself.
