
As his dark thoughts press in on him again, he remembers Evangela showing him "The Fortress of Rest". Chris flees to this safe place hoping God will have something there to help him.

Chris Soldier believes in The Lord Jesus Christ as His personal Saviour. The moment Chris believed in Jesus God forgave his sins and gave him the perfect








Chris Soldier finds God's Armor so strong and powerful against his dark thoughts, he never wants to face a day without it!

God loves you very much and He wants you to live in Heaven with Him. (1John 4:8)




