Summary:

(Place of worship – God's leader's altars of uncut stones Exodus 20:25)

Pre-creation, Creation & Garden (6 days of creation & God's 1st Sabbath Gen 2:1-7): *Jesus was already here...*

- In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1 I am Alpha and Omega, ...beginning and the end, ..., which is..., was..., and is to come... Rev 1:18, 13:8, ...slain before the foundation of the world. Rev 13:8, I Peter 1:19-20 ...I beheld Satan as lightening fall from heaven. Luke 10:18
- Earth & man: The earth was founded (made) upon the waters (H2O) Psalms 24:2, Let us make man... Gen 1:26
- All tree fruits in God's Garden were for Adam & Eve to enjoy except the fruit of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Genesis 2:16-17 Though warned by God that they would surely die in the day they eat of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, Eve was enticed by the devil to eat of the forbidden fruit. Adam harkened unto his wife and ate the fruit too. Now accursed, they would live as slaves to sin, knowing about good and evil. They are sent out of the Garden by God, so they will not eat from the tree of life and live forever in their sin state. God's day is as 1000 years, man "surely" died within a day (1000 years) when Adam ate of the forbidden fruit. The longest person to live was Methuselah - 969 years.

Post Garden (After Adam and Eve were sent out of the Garden by God):

- Men of God lead (When men righteously followed God, rarely did women need to lead. ...Isa 3:12)
- Enoch so walked with God that God took him - No death.
- By Genesis Ch 6:3, God's heart is grieved for making now sinful man.
- God decreases man's lifespan down to 120 years.
- Righteous Noah gets grace from God during world flood. He and his seven family members are saved on God's ark. God's rainbow is a sign of the covenant (no more world floods) to man and all life on earth.
- Babel tower event, God is forced to move people across the world and separates them by languages.
- Abraham goes to Canaan (Israel today). He gives Melchizedek of Salem (*Jeru-salem*) both priest & king of the most high God without beginning or end the 1st tithe mentioned in the Bible. Gen 14:18-20, Heb 7:1-4
- God destroys the sinful cities of Sodom and Gomorrah by fire.
- The covenant lineage of Abraham is to: son Isaac, to Jacob (Israel), to his 12 sons (12 tribes of Israel)...
- Land promised to Abraham & covenant descendants, & purchased burial: Gen 12:1-7, Psalms 132, Ch 23
- Abraham's son Ishmael was promised to become a great nation, & be a great adversary: Gen 16:12, 17:20
- Job was a man who was perfect, upright, feared God and eschewed evil. Job was faithful through his evil trials despite his wife's & friends' criticism. He was blessed double for all his trouble by almighty God.
