Matthew 2h 30m	Genealogy of Jesus through David and the kings to Joseph (His father’s side) – Matthew 1
Mark 1h 30m	The lineages in Matthew 1 and Luke 3 split at Davids’s sons Solomon and Nathan.
Luke 2h 30m	Genealogy of Jesus also through David and the kings in line (possibly His mother’s side) – Luke 3
John 2h	Matthew 1 (“son of” = can include indirect bloodline), “Joseph” was the “supposed” father of Jesus
Acts Ch 1:1-12 3m	Luke 3 (“begat” = actual bloodline) – Luke 3 believed by some scholars to be Mary’s side

Summary:

(Places of worship - The Temple & synagogues)

- Jesus was a Jew of the lineage of David. He was born of the Holy Spirit through the virgin Mary.
- He is the true King, Heaven’s King (Rev 19:16), priest (Heb 4:14-16) and King *as was Melchizedek*. Heb 7:1-2
- He was not comely (handsome), and he was afflicted. Isaiah 53:2-4
- The voice of the prophet John the Baptist, Jesus’ cousin, breaks the silence of the Old Testament.
- John baptizes Jesus in the Jordan River, and the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are all present together.
- At 30 years of age, Jesus began His earth-shaking ministry that shocks the Jews and amazes the world when with power, he heals the sick, cleanses the lepers, raises the dead, and casts out devils. Luke 4:16-21
- Jesus was sent to minister to the lost sheep of the house of Israel (Abraham’s lineage). Matt 10:5-6, 15:24 Jesus’ loving ministry was earth shaking and offensive to some of the religious Jews. “The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them. And blessed is he whosoever is not offended in me.” Matt 11:5 – 6
- Jesus cleanses the Temple, His fathers Holy house, by whipping the sellers out with their unholy acts.
- Jesus said, “David spoke of me in the Psalms.” Luke 24:44
- A new commandment I give you, “Love one another as I have loved you.” John 13:34
- He ministered God’s grace (God’s redeeming law of love without merit/free), & the Gospel/Good news of God’s Kingdom directly to those who had an “ear to hear.” He ministered often in parables.
- Jesus came to free us from sin and death by fulfilling God’s law through his shed blood on calvary’s cross. The Blood of the lamb/Jesus, shed on Calvary’s cross, signified that we can be redeemed from the curse of the law! When Jesus was crucified on the cross, He took on the sins of all. John 3:16, Heb 9:12 After he died, for three days He descended into hell, separated from His Father. He came alive again and for forty days he was seen of men. Acts 1:3 He then ascended into heaven to sit on His Father’s right hand. Jesus transferred the God head power in the earth to the Holy Spirit, which began the time of the church.
- After Jesus’ ascension, his disciples ministered in the following order. ...and ye shall be witnesses of me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:8
