

12 Bible Eras Reading Pacing Guide

One Year	Scholarly fast	1 Era each month
Two Years	Fast	1 Era every 2 months
Three Years	Moderate	1 Era every 3 months
Four Years	Slow	1 Era every 4 months
Five Years	Scholarly Slow	1 Era every 5 months

Note: *This pacing guide is not based on exact reading times. Some of the 12 Era scriptures sections have more pages to read than others. Some scriptures in some Eras are easier to read than in others. Despite the length of pages or difficulty of the reading in an era, the format of the 12 Eras allows readers to adopt a general pace in which to read the entire Bible.*

The “Silent Era” has the least amount of scripture, but it is a time to get an understanding of the historical events that take place at that time. This era’s timeline is based on the historical events described in the prophecy of the Prophet Daniel from King Nebuchadnezzar’s dream. Also, during the Silent Era, it is time to gain an understanding of many Jewish customs and events that will be seen in the next Era during the time of Jesus and the reading of the four Gospels.
