INTRODUCTION

Author: The Apostle Paul

Date: Written @56 AD (a leap year) in Corinth while on his 3rd missionary journey. Written during the reign of Nero.

Audience: Church leaders in Rome that Paul had not met yet both Jew and Gentile. These leaders were probably converted to Christianity through the teachings of Peter.

Rome is located of the banks of the Tiber River. It was the center of the Empire. It was an ethnically diverse population with 1 million people in an area less than 10 square miles. Rome was predominantly Gentile but within its population were about 40-50 thousand Jews.

This letter was written in a time when Jews were just returning to Rome after the repeal of Emperor Claudius' expulsion order of the Jews by his successor, Nero. As Jewish converts to Christianity returned to Rome, there were tensions between the Jewish Christians and the Gentile Christians as well as the tension between he Jews who professed Jesus as the Messiah and those who did not. It is believed that Jews were converted during their exile from Rome. Paul speaks to the need for all to hear the Gospel and receive Christ as their savior.

Religion: Roman religion was complex. The influence of Greek and Jewish culture added to the complexity of their religious beliefs. They worshipped many Roman and Greek gods. Judaism and secret cults were also prevalent during this time. The religious practices of the day were dependent on knowledge and the correct practice of prayer (recited liturgies), rituals, and sacrifice. None of their religious traditions were based on any kind of faith or grace.

Motivation: To enlist help to reach people in Spain, to address division among Christians, to proclaim the universal significance of the Gospel.
