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President's Notes

Happy Spring, here's the news! April is Acres Green Homeowners Association Membership month. Dues cover the publishing and mailing of the Newsletter to all 1,056 homes, electricity at the marquees, and providing the dumpster day for those who have paid their membership. The cost is \$40.00 per household. In October it was decided to have one dumpster day in June only. Do the residents want the newsletter to be continued? Do you want more activities? A suggestion has been introduced to change the AGHOA title for residents to understand our role – that suggestion is "Neighborhood Community Association". The name, as we're registered, can't be changed. We are not a typical HOA with rules governing what your property looks like or how many cars you can have in your driveway. Fifty years ago, and today, we are not able to tell you what you can do on your property. Douglas County zoning and property laws only can. The electrical repair cost at the Maximus Dr. entrance is still unknown and we won't know more until it warms up. The location of the actual problem hasn't been determined yet and is different than first reported by Xcel in Dec 2022. It looks like it'll be our cost to bear. 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Acres Green Garden Project

The front garden to the East of the marquee and at the main entrance to Acres Green Drive needs attention. Its deteriorating appearance doesn't offer community beauty or pride. We are looking to improve our garden horticulture, with your help. Contributions and involvement are key to its success, and we have brainstormed some ideas. A rock garden area will be established by May, for families to bring rocks down. Soon areas will be zoned for bulbs, plants, bushes, and trees. No water is available for this plot and all plants must be Perennials and drought hardy. This area was originally paved as Acres Green Drive and beneath the surface there is a layer of asphalt. Calling all community members to contribute a small amount of time to plant and donate to our garden. Rainwater Harvesting

Do you know that Colorado law allows the use of rain barrels to collect rainwater? There's a maximum of 2 barrels allowed with a combined total of 110 gallons. Captured untreated rainwater is not safe to drink. Rainwater is unchlorinated, and generally soft and low in salt making it beneficial for watering your plants and garden.
