Grill Safe

When was the last time you cleaned your gas grill really well? And I don't mean just the grates. Consider my learning experience below as some free advice that may be worth more than you're paying for it. Grilled some burgers Saturday night and had some flare-ups but nothing serious – burgers often flare when flipped. Preheated the grill the next night to cook some fish and before putting anything on the grill we had flames. BIG FLAMES running down the inside of the grill, lighting the drip pan and the entire inside of the grill. Before we knew it the flames were lapping up on the outside of

the grill and dangerously close to the propane bottle. Quickly turned off the bottle and disconnected the supply line. Only lost a little hair on the back of my hands but got the bottle away from the grill. Ran for the fire extinguisher because by now the fire was getting serious with black soot and intense heat. Fire extinguisher won't spray. Dial indicates it's empty! UH OH! Luckily had a second extinguisher in a closet in the house. It worked and put out the fire. Probably the scariest 2 minutes of my life. Luckily the grill was next to a brick wall and not vinyl siding or even wood or results would have been much worse. Lessons learned: Clean the grill and drip pans frequently to prevent this from happening in the future. Check fire extinguishers frequently and have a spare nearby. Make sure the extinguishers are rated for grease fires. Teach children in the house how to use the extinguishers in case you need help. Be safe and enjoy those cookouts! Your neighbor, Alan.
