New Membership

The Acres Green Homeowner Association (AGHOA) voted to raise membership dues from \$25.00 annually to a flat \$40.00 per household beginning January 1, 2024. Membership would begin January 1 for all members and be active through December 31, 2024. This is a change from prior years when Memberships could be paid in October, November, or December and would

carry through to the following year. The proposed changes will be discussed at the Annual Members Meeting on October 12, 2023 at Canvas Credit Union at 10000 Park Meadows Drive – South entrance 6-8 PM.

- Prior Plan: \$25.00 Families, \$15.00 Individuals, \$5.00 Seniors. Payments in Oct/Nov/Dec carry through to the following year.
- Changed to \$40.00 Household beginning Jan. 1, 2024, ending December 31, 2024.

As everyone is keenly aware, costs continue to rise - locations to host the HOA meetings for free are becoming scarce. Expenses for Dumpster Day, Electronics Recycling, and Shredding have increased significantly. AGHOA membership has dropped from 186 households in 2021 to 155 in 2022 & 2023. At \$25.00 per membership, the HOA has gone from roughly \$4,650 per year to \$3,875 in two years - an almost \$800 decrease. Offering Dumpster Day twice each year is an expense of \$2,000 - almost the entire annual budget for 2023. The dues have not been raised since 1973, when the AGHOA was formed.

AGHOA is a **voluntary** HOA for the Acres Green Neighborhood. Volunteer Board Members and committee chairpersons work to build a sense of community within the neighborhood by hosting events and activities that are free for the community to enjoy. The HOA also advocates on behalf of neighbors within Acres Green in discussions with public agencies to ensure the community's voices are heard. While membership is optional, the HOA believes there are great reasons to pay dues annually including:

- Keeping the lights shining on and maintaining the Acres Green signs at the entrances to the neighborhood.
- Staying current with neighborhood activities by sending 6 issues of the Acres
 Green Scene to every home throughout the year (The Greenleaf newsletter
 was delivered for 30 years).
- Hosting the Acres Green Website @ www.acresgreen.org to share information on events and activities.
- Providing new residents with Welcome to the Neighborhood Packets
- Organizing 2 community-wide yard sales; 4th of July activities to include a Parade, water balloon and Ice Cream Social; Food Truck Nights; Neighborhood-wide Contests - Lawns of the Month, 4th of July Sidewalk

Chalk contest, Best of Car in Parade and Holiday Decorating Contests; Front Yard Parties; a Neighborhood 50th Anniversary Block Party; and a Halloween event.

- Advising neighbors with the Architectural Control Committee (Getting a letter from the ACC could save you 10 days of processing of your construction permit requests).
- Cleaning up the Community Garden in the front of the neighborhood

 Advocating and sharing information between various organizations on behalf of the Acres Green Neighborhood, including the City of Lone Tree, South Suburban Parks and Recreation, and Douglas County.

AGHOA does not enforce penalties on property owners. The covenants of the community do not restrict parking an RV or restoring a classic car in your garage. There will be no notices to paint your home or front door a specific, pre-selected color. While AGHOA does not have prohibitive covenants or restrictions, AGHOA is not the only governing body for the neighborhood. Please be aware that Douglas County does have restrictions, which are enforced by the Douglas County Zoning Department. If you have questions about what is enforced by the Zoning Department, please call 303-660-7460 or visit https://www.douglas.co.us/planning/development-review-regulations/zoning/.

With at least 155 households who paid for the annual membership in 2023, this change increases the budget to \$6,200 annually, ensures the free events and activ-

ities the community enjoys can continue and allows opportunities to take advantage of South Suburban Parks and Recreation's Matching Funds Grants to work with SSPRD to improve our neighborhood. In the past this included the bench on Maximus Drive, rocks between Kohls and Altair Park and the landscaping in front of the marquees at both entrances. The hope is that with more funds, the HOA can continue to offer free, community-building events throughout the year, and services that benefit everyone living in Acres Green.

South Suburban Parks and Recreation (SSPR) Update

In August the SSPR forester and a team spent 4 days working on the trees in the median. They pruned several trees and removed one of the dead trees. SSPR is committed to replacing 3 trees per year over the next 3 years. Additionally, we brought a couple of items to SSPRs attention and they're working on these. The items were the clogged drainage area at Altair Park and at the end of Acres Green Dr (debris has been moved from the drainpipe area at Altair Park, but requires additional removal), The ballpark fence condition at Altair Park fixed, and the utility markers left in the median since June (They've been removed).

Additionally, we inquired about having restroom services available at Lonesome Pine Park and were provided the following feedback: "We do not pay for porta-potties in the parks. When they are present, they are charged back to the sport group that is permitted to use the fields at the park. A standard one is \$150 per month with 2x per week cleaning and an ADA one is \$358 per month with 2x per week cleaning. Most of them are pulled at the end of the sport season because we (SSPR) are not budgeted to pay for them when the sport groups are not active". The AGHOA is willing to pursue working with Douglas County to submit a proposal for restroom services at Lonesome Pine Park via the annual long term budget process if the community is interested.
