We want to thank our residents! Many individuals are helping our community! Steve Ebling has been cutting the grass in front of the Maximus Drive marquee. Santiago Hernandez, our neighbor how owns All Seasons

Landscaping and snow removal LLC spent 3 hours cutting and trimming the Acres Green Drive median in June. CR and many residents are maintaining the entrances to and around by keeping them mowed and weeded. An anonymous mother and daughter, along with an older gentleman, are seen picking up trash in the medians along Acres Green Drive. Carlos Maciel, our resident master gardener, and DougCo school kids who stopped by to work on the AG garden.

Acres Green Drive Study

Mile High Flood District (MHFD) completed a study of the Willow Creek Tributaries upstream of Englewood Dam. This study was completed in 2024 and resulted in the publication of a Major Drainageway Plan. The study was a joint sponsorship with Southeast Metro Stormwater Authority (SEMSWA), Douglas County, and the City of Lone Tree. Acres Green Drive is one of the tributaries included in this study. The study determined the following regarding Acres Green Drive.

- Stream function is rated **poor**, and crossings at Maximus Drive and Apollo Circle are rated as impaired.
- Proposed changes include Stream Restoration and Stream Rehabilitation
- The recommended budget for Stream Restoration is \$2.4 million, with SSPR responsible.
- Stream Restoration reflects larger-scale capital improvement projects (CIP) involving full channel re-grading and construction of new structures.
- The recommended budget for Stream Rehabilitation is \$650,000, with the city of Centennial (SEMSWA, SSPRD, and HOA) responsible.
- Stream Rehabilitation reflects point repairs to out-falls, grade control structures, and eroded banks to maintain the function of the stream systems.
- Culvert upsize at Apollo Circle is required
- Increase the inlet grate to reduce clogging
- Budgeted \$20,000 with Douglas County responsible

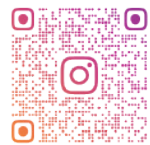

Trash, Junk Inoperative Vehicles

While walking in the neighborhood, I often strike up conversations with the people I meet. Several subjects seem to arise frequently, and "I have been asked" to research the Douglas County regulations so residents can understand their responsibilities. Prevalent issues include abandoned, inoperative, or unlicensed vehicles, as well as difficulty walking on sidewalks due to unkempt property. The following is a section from the Douglas County Ordinance.

Unincorporated Douglas County Ordinance

Section 2 #208. Trash, Junk, Inoperative Vehicles

No land may be used as an outside storage area for the purpose of collecting, dismantling, storing, or selling of junk, trash, rubbish, refuse of any kind, remnants of wood, metal, or plastic, discarded materials, inoperative vehicles or dismantled machinery, whether or not the same could be put to any reasonable use, unless approved as a use by special review in the GI zoning district." Essentially, this County ordinance makes it a violation to collect inoperative vehicles, trash, and junk anywhere on your property.
