## TIPS FOR TESTIFYING at the MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN 2025

Testimony must be submitted at: http://mgaleg.maryland.gov. Click on the icon MyMGA (upper right corner of the homepage)

- A. You must set up an "Account" at MyMGA. All written testimony must be submitted as a "pdf" file.
- B. You must sign up to testify in the House or Senate for either written or oral testimony 2 work days prior to the hearing between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. using your MyMGA account. Oral testimony is limited to 2 minutes.
- C. Oral testimony can be either in-person or virtual. You must choose one when signing up.

REMINDER: When representing the MFRW or your Club YOU are the face of the Republican Party.

## When testifying:

- 1. Always be respectful, polite and cordial. Thank the Committee for the opportunity to testify.
- 2. Provide extra details, charts or amendments in written form (refer to them in oral testimony).
- 3. Oral Testimony: Prepare an Outline of main points or write out entire testimony.
- 4. Practice your testimony before a mirror. TIME IT.
- 5. State your name, your organization, and the Bill number and subject of your testimony. 6. State your position on the bill: a. I/We support requiring a voter to show a government-issued Photo ID to vote because (give facts, statistics, illustrative story and benefits). Or, b. We oppose because (state any problems or damage the bill would cause and who or what would be damaged). c. We oppose this bill in its present form because \_\_\_\_\_(facts), but if it amended to \_\_\_\_(state needed changes) we could support it (or not oppose it). 7. Close by saying: "We urge the committee to vote for a favorable (or unfavorable) report for \_\_\_\_bill
- number. Or, Please give HB\_\_\_\_\_ a FAVORABLE report.
- 8. If representing your club or MFRW, tell the committee about the MFRW such as:

At the Beginning: I am (name) from \_\_\_county and I am representing the \_\_\_\_ Club of the Maryland Federation of Republican Women. The MFRW is the largest Republican membership organization in Maryland with 1154 members in 26 unit clubs. Or in closing: On behalf of the Maryland Federation of Republican Women, the largest Republican membership

organization in Maryland with 1154 members and 26 unit clubs, I urge your Favorable Report for bill number. 9. If you are asked a question that you don't have an answer to, reply: I don't know the answer to your

- question, but I will check on it and provide an answer to the Chairman as soon as possible. Be sure to follow up.
- 10. For effective testimony
  - a. Read the bill and the Fiscal Note thoroughly. (view at http://mgaleg.maryland.gov)
  - b. Check to see if an identical or similar bill was introduced last year.
  - c. If so, did the bill get out of committee?
  - d. How did the members of the committee vote?
  - e. Check who are the Republicans on the Committee? Email/talk with them before the hearing.
