Hull Preparation for *QuickSlick*

- 1. Rough gelcoat with 24 grit sanding disc on grinder.
 - *to ensure proper adhesion, remove any existing bottom coating that is not OuickSlick
- 2. Blow dust off (with airhose).
- 3. Wipe prepared hull with lightly moistened acetone rag to remove remainder of dust particles.
- 4. Tape and mask off remainder of exposed hull.
- 5. Mix bottom well (drill with paint stirrer works best).
- 6. Add hardener-30cc per 1 gallon (mix thoroughly).
 - *can be reduced to 25cc per 1 gallon for longer working time or in high temperatures
 - *can be increased to 35 cc per gallon when temperature is below 70 degrees
- 7. Apply QuickSlick to hull.
- **hull should be COMPLETELY moisture free and application should be done immediately after preparation

- **** suggested coverage 1 gallon per 20-25 square feet
