



December's Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation report came out 1/12/23 and headline inflation was -0.1%. Great news, we had negative inflation mostly due to food and energy costs dropping. Core inflation (removing volatile food and energy prices) was up 0.3%. Not a bad number...

But if we dive deeper, Core CPI rose 0.3%, but that is due to the "shelter" aspect of the CPI report that said shelter (Housing) costs rose by 0.8% in December! Wait a minute... Home prices are falling

all over the nation, Month over Month actual rents have been dropping for several months in a row. How did we just have the largest shelter monthly increase in almost a year??

The metrics our inflation reports use are far from perfect. Specifically for Shelter calculations, they are extremely delayed. Real shelter costs are dropping like a rock, but the CPI reports show them increasing. Why is this important? In 3-9 months it is very likely that the CPI reports will finally catch up and show negative shelter/housing inflation. And when those negative shelter costs combine with other areas that are reducing in cost as well, we might see inflation come down extremely quickly. When inflation comes down, mortgage rates come down as well!




