## BARBER APPRENTICESHIP

A barber apprenticeship is a 2000-hour training program for aspiring barbers, *typically those who already* have intermediate cutting skills, to work under an experienced Licensed Barber. Barber apprenticeships typically take approximately 2 years to complete. The apprenticeship is broken into two separate programs.

One program is 150 hours of theory, which must be completed at an approved Barbering School like "Bravado Academy." This is a 12-week program. It is 100% online. You MUST have access to a computer and the internet. Assignments are released on Mondays at 8:00am and are due the following Sunday by 11:59pm. You may work at your own pace; however, assignments must be submitted by due date. This program prepares for the Ct. State exam. You will learn the state guidelines, expectations, and practical procedures to successfully pass the state board examination and become a professional licensed barber.

**Second program** is finding yourself a barbershop to take you on as an apprentice and training you for 850 hours. The school is not responsible for finding students shops to apprentice at. You must contact the Dept of Labor to register for this portion of the program at

The two programs are separate from one another and are two separate businesses. They do not intertwine. However, you may enroll in both programs simultaneously or one after the other, it's your choice.
