

Students are required to complete 1000 hours of training as designated by the Connecticut state law. Our course is a complete basic barbering program which include haircutting and styling for men as well as state health laws and regulations. This program prepares for the Ct. State exam. You will learn barbering skills and state guidelines, expectations, and practical procedures to successfully pass the state board examination to become a professional licensed barber.

Theory Portion

is 100% online. You MUST have access to a computer and the internet. Assignments are released on Mondays at 8:00am and are due the following Sunday by 11:59pm. You may work at your own pace; however, assignments must be submitted by due date.

Hands-on Portion (Haircutting)

held at 1258 Gold Star HWY Groton, CT. 06320 on Thursdays & Fridays from 9:00am to 3:00 pm and are inperson only. Students are required to have their complete student kits with them during each in-person class.

BARBER APPRENTICESHIP

A barber apprenticeship is a 2000-hour training program for aspiring barbers, *typically those who already have intermediate cutting skills*, to work under an experienced Licensed Barber. Barber apprenticeships typically take approximately 2 years to complete. The apprenticeship is broken into two separate programs.

One program is 150 hours of theory, which must be completed at an approved Barbering School like *"Bravado Academy."* This is a 12-week program. It is 100% online. You MUST have access to a computer and the internet. Assignments are released on Mondays at 8:00am and are due the following Sunday by 11:59pm. You may work at your own pace; however, assignments must be submitted by due date. This program prepares for the Ct. State exam. You will learn the state guidelines, expectations, and practical procedures to successfully pass the state board examination and become a professional licensed barber.

Registration Fee (non-refundable) \$110.00 Tuition \$1,515.00 Books (non-refundable) \$75.00 Total Cost \$1,700.00

Second program is finding yourself a barbershop to take you on as an apprentice and training you for 850 hours. The school is not responsible for finding students shops to apprentice at. You must contact the Dept of Labor to register for this portion of the program at

The Office of Apprenticeship Training - Apprenticeship Forms (state.ct.us).

The two programs are separate from one another and are two separate businesses. They do not intertwine. However, you may enroll in both programs simultaneously or one after the other, it's your choice.



Graduation Requirements

- 75% or above in academics
- Completion of 1000 hours/150 for apprenticeship
- Meet all financial obligations with our school.

UPON GRADUATING

Student will receive a diploma and have the necessary requirements to become a Connecticut Licensed Barber

Student is responsible for registering for CT State Board and applying for license and the license fee of \$100.00
