

Dear Citizens,

Proposed Data Center at 2400 O'Kelly Road...

What we know:

- * 900,000 total sq ft of buildings
- * somewhere between 200,000 - 500,000 gallons of water per DAY, 80% of which will be evaporated depending on the cooling systems installed
- * minimal employees
- * the planning and zoning commission has approved this project in a 4 to 0 vote
(next step will be for the Board of Commissioners final vote – October 23rd)

What we don't know:

- * the electrical requirements/usage
- *** **will our water/electricity utility costs go up to support this venture**
- * which of the 4 types of data centers is being built
- * environmental impacts
- *** **water caps by City of Gainesville Water Dept. for the data center when Lake Lanier is below full pool**
- *** **who is the owner of this data center**

We desperately need to get this information out to our fellow citizens. Please tell your neighbors, friends, relatives. These answers are important and right now they are unknown. Our Hall County government is set to vote before before these studies are finished. Plan to attend the **October 23, 2025** county commission voting meeting and let your thoughts be known. Even if you don't wish to speak, your presence alone will speak volumes. We need for this item to be tabled, at bare minimum, until we have more answers as to how this will impact our supply of water and electricity.
