ASPCA National Animal Poison Control Center 1-888-426-4435

If your pet ingests something you suspect is poisonous, you can call this 24-hour service and pay a \$65.00 fee for a consultation with a veterinarian.

Pet Loss Support Hotline 1-888-478-7574

This hotline, run by the Iowa State University College of Veterinary Medicine, provides a source of emotional support for people who have lost a pet or who are about to lose a pet. This 24-hour line allows you to leave a message, and your call will be returned seven days a week between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. CST and May through August, Wednesdays and Fridays, 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. CST. This is a free service.

This service can assist you if you think your pet has been stolen.
