## Seven Bridges Field Club Tennis and Paddle Policy 2025 Season:



- 1) The tennis and paddle courts are for the exclusive use of the members of Seven Bridges Field Club and their guests
- 2) At least one club member must be playing in any group
- All players must wear proper tennis shoes on the tennis courts
- 4) Tennis courts must be swept and lines cleaned after use.
- 5) If a net has been lowered, it is because the court is not playable
- 6) If there has been recent rain and the courts are wet, please do not play on them
- 7) If there is a problem on any of the courts, please notify the tennis chair: David Markowitz (<a href="mailto:dmarkowitz914@gmail.com">dmarkowitz914@gmail.com</a> or cell 914-393-0144)
- 8) Guests will be charged a court fee of \$15 per session. A session can be any length of time on a given day. This rate applies for each guest for either singles or doubles on both the tennis and paddle courts. This fee may be paid by the member or the guest
- 9) Payment can be made via
  - a. Zelle to sevenbridgesfieldclub@gmail.com
  - b. Cash or a check (made out to Seven Bridges Field Club) left in the drop box located on the tennis court bulletin board
- 10) Paddle courts are open all year long and may be used between 8:00 am and 10:00 PM seven days per week
- 11) Lights on the paddle courts should be turned off at the completion of play. Lights and heater inside the warming hut should also be turned off
- 12) Locks on paddle courts and the warming hut must be secured after completion of play
- 13) If a group arrives while the paddle courts are full, the maximum entire (not additional) playing time is one hour. Otherwise there is no time limit
- 14) Clearing snow off the paddle courts
  - Snow should be removed from the paddle courts only with plastic shovels (metal shovels and salt destroy the surface of the courts)
  - b. Remove any snow prior to turning on the heaters to reduce the amount of propane used.
  - C. Please turn off heaters once the courts are clear.
  - d. Do not shovel snow directly off paddle court 1 on the side of the court facing the pool (this is marked with signs) as this will block access to the heating system below the court.
