A Yeah.....Sure its possible. We, we never--although I--why, why wouldn't I just let a plumber go down there too, though? And not telling him that I, ya know, I...wanted to dig where the boozey belt (?) was and I wasn't afraid of him digging.

Q Dig where the what was?

A The bozzey belt (?) that comes in from the front, because I thought that there was something wrong--why did I--I have never let anyone figure out why the hell the goddamn ground holds such, so much water. You could dig a foot down--you could go down in the crawlspace and dig a foot down and then as you dig the foot down, leave it stand two days, and that hole would be filled with water. Like a natural spring under there.

Q Do you remember any other specifics from any other of those five that you dug? Picking them up, bringing them home, the killings?

A I would, I, I think that I recall that I recall something about Uptown area. Around Montrose, Montrose & Clark, somewhere in there....picking up somebody, but I, I think he was 22 or 23 years old, but I don't know, I don't recall.

Q How did you feel the next morning when you woke up and you found Godzik dead? What was your initial emotional response?

A Just to throw him down in the crawlspace. Get rid of him.

Q Did you question yourself as to why it was done?

A Nope.....

Q What about Szyk? When you woke up--oh, that was when Rossi was there.....

A I don't--uh, with Godzik, I felt a little upset about it, because I even wanted to help with, with his mother. I even volunteered to help.

Q Do you ever remember feeling remorse for any of this? What was your most overwhelming feeling? Fear? Remorse? You wanted to get rid of it and put it out of your mind, cover it up?

- A See but once you bury somebody, then it was already gone. There was, there was no feeling to, Bob, in fact, for the most part, ya know, even like today, I don't, I don't believe I killed anybody. But yet I know I did, or I took part in it.
- Q When you found the body the next morning, did you ever think, "Well, Jesus, there's already three down there, or there's already seven down there." Did you ever, do you have a count in your mind? When you were going to go out drinking the night before, did it ever.....?
- A No, you want to know something, I think in fact, the one, in fact the one time I dug down there, I uncovered a body while I was digging....
- Q What was your reaction when you did that? How did you feel?
- A Frightening.....
- Q Did you ever think when you were going out at night that possibly you'd end up with another body the next morning? Did you ever think about that when you were going out--say you'd leave the house to have a few drinks somewhere?
- A Well, yeah in this, in this last year, here, I kept telling myself that I gotta keep myself busy--busy, busy, busy--so that I don't have time to go down by the park--stay away from down there--don't go down by the lakefront.
- Q Did you ever try to figure out in your own mind what was happening to you?
- A See cause, ya know, like in my own nei--, in my own neighborhood, or even along the streets, er, er, like Montrose, or Lawrence or anything or even anywhere in Norridge, if I seen hitchhikers or that, I would not pick up nobody around my house. I would not pick up nobody in my own neighborhood.
- Q Did you ever, during the course of your days, did you think about this--did you think about the bodies under your house--did you think about what you probably had done, even though you didn't remember specifically--was it on your mind a lot during the day?
- A None of it was....the only, alright, once, once the burial was done there, there was no number count, there was no nothing in my mind.
