- St. Theresa Girls Secondary School, Kibuye: July 19, 2025







## Performance goals are a good way to monitor and measure progress.



#### **Know the Signs:**


- Receiving repeated, unwanted messages that make you feel scared or upset.






## DIGITAL SAFETY PLEDGE
