The program seeks to give hope and advocate for the integration of a sustainable and inclusive approach to promoting education and literacy among marginalized children such as children affected by emergencies, street children, children in protective care, orphans, teenage mothers and children living in slums.

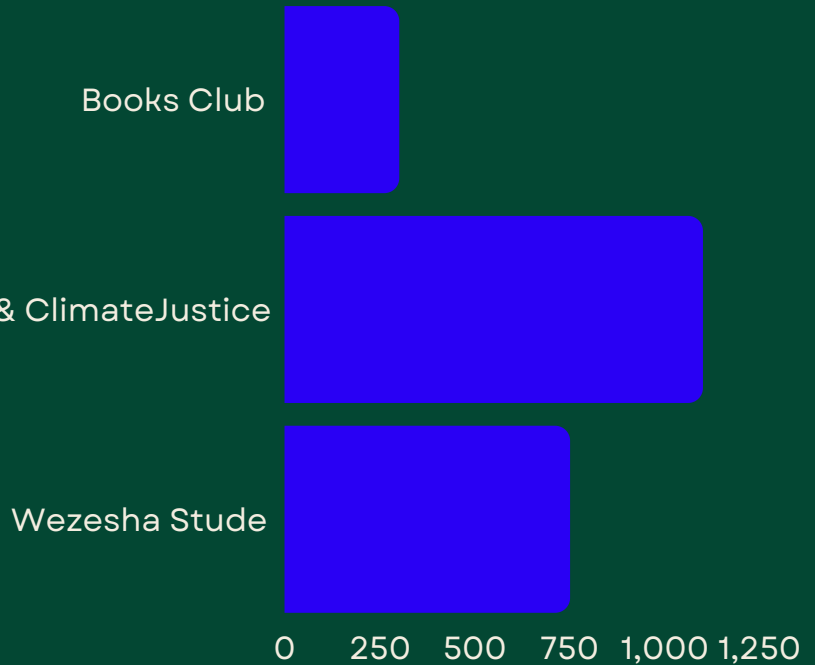

Wezesha Stude Mentorship

Seeks to instil knowledge, power and influence mentee (students) personality development, intellectual capabilities and career success

- Provided a structured approach for goal setting
- Offering educational sponsorship to 2 girls rescued from Early Marriage

Environmental and Climate Justice Education

Empower Young people with accurate knowledge of Environmental and Climate Justice issues i.e activism, food insecurity, pollution, gender inequality, loss and damage financing


- Educated out to over 1000 community members, students and youth Environment Justice and Climate Financing

Community Mobile Library

Empower vulnerable children in slums to be able to read and comprehend

- Target 200 children in slum areas on weekly basis
