**Bigha** and **Katha** measurements vary significantly by region, so it's essential to verify the local conversions.

1. **Ground** is primarily used in Tamil Nadu.
2. **Guntha** is commonly used in Maharashtra, Karnataka
3. **Marla** is primarily used in Punjab and Haryana.
4. **Cent** is commonly used in Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Kerala and Tamil Nadu.
