MAKING A DIFFERENCE

43 children received preschool tuition assistance allowing them to attend a quality preschool program.

22 children were provided transportation to attend Head Start.

46 families received education, resources and support through 537 in-home visits.

197 children received an oral health screening and 4% of those were referred on for additional services or treatment.

100% of child care programs involved in our NICA program improved the health and safety conditions in their early learning environments.

46 children continuation of an early childhood education through Head Start.

28% of licensed and registered child care providers are rated on the Quality Rating System (QRS).
