




Start Sequence

| Signal | Sound | Minutes start | Flag |
|--------------------|---------|-------------------------|--|
| Attention | 1 short | 10 minutes |  F flag up. |
| 1 min to warming | 1 long | 6 minutes |  F flag down |
| warming | 1 short | 5 minutes |  Class flag up |
| prepare | 1 short | 4 minutes |  P flag up |
| 1 min to start | 1 long | 1 minute |  P flag down |
| start/next warming | 1 long | 5 minutes to next start |  Class flag down/New up |

Basic start strategies

- Starboard has rights
- Port must stay clear
- Pin
- RC
- Leeward has rights
- Windward must stay clear

Basic mark rounding rules

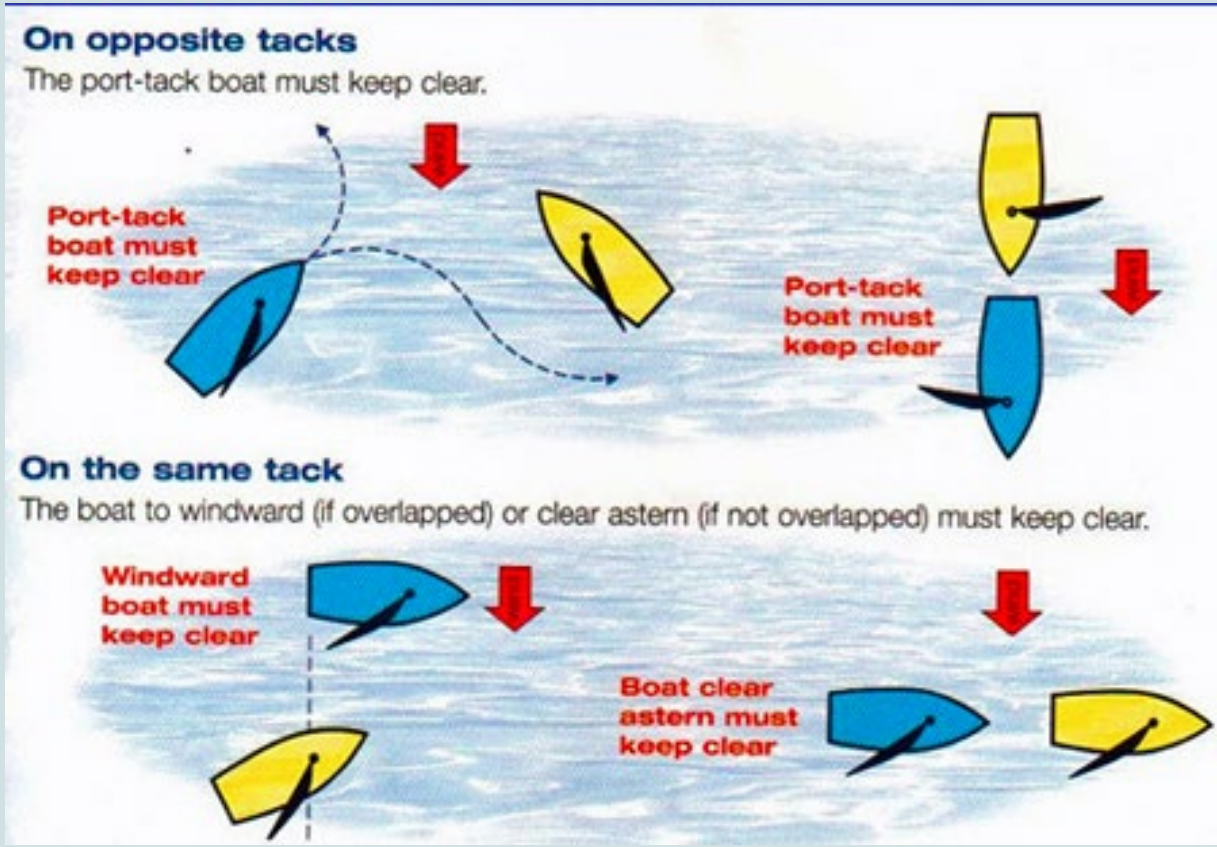
- Starboard has rights
- Overlapping must give a room
- Port vs Starboard rounding (see sailing instructions)

Sailing on the course

- Starboard has rights
 - Leeward has rights
 - Overtaken has rights
-
- Port must stay clear
 - Windward must stay clear
 - Overtaking must stay clear

Avoid collision regardless the rules.

Navigation Rules



Finish

- See blue flag on the RC
- Depends on the course, finish might be starboard or port to RC
- See sailing instructions on Yacht Scoring for details.

Award Ceremony and Party

- No more races after 3pm
- Award ceremony right after the race.
- Party at the Corinthian Club (Bar and Food)
- Party in the front the club.
- Access to the club only with card or friend.
- Restroom inside the club.

Race Committee and help

- RC boat (5 people plus PRO)
 - Hoist flags
 - Whistle
 - Write boat numbers before start
 - Write start time
 - Write finish time or place
- Markset boat (2 people)
 - Setup start, finish and windward mark
 - Clean up after the race
- Safety boat (2 people)
 - Help boats that capsized or need help
 - Help markset boat.
