ELIGIBILITY, INFORMATION, AND RULES

- 1. The essay must be original and neither previously published nor secured by copyright.
- 2. The type written essays must be double spaced using in Aerial 12 font.
- 3. Each **Header Page** of your essays must include the following: **Your full name; current high school; and intended college.**
- 4. The essay can be submitted in either Microsoft WORD.doc or PDF format. (PDF is recommended).

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ESSAY RATING CRITERIA

The Reason Essay and Reflection Essay submissions can earn individual rating of 100 points each. Combined: The maximum to score is 200 points.

- 1. Development of Topic/ Thesis: (30 possible points)
 - Topic is well-developed (covers and develops major points, supplying enough information for understanding)
- 2. Progression: (20 possible points)
 - o Composition progresses from beginning to end in a logical flow of information
- 3. Readability: (25 possible points)
 - o Concise prose that sticks to the point and does not ramble (holds reader's attention)
- 4. Grammar: (10 possible points)
 - Agreement of subject and verb; proper tense; correct sentence construction; and paragraphing
- 5. Spelling: (5 possible points)
- 6. Punctuation: (5 possible points)
- 7. GPA: (5 points) The GPAs will be confirmed by official transcript.

o 3.50 and above = 2 pts

o 3.90 and above = 4 pts.

 \circ 3.30 and above = 1 pts.

 \circ 3.70 and above = 3 pts.
