Arrowhead Luncheon Price Increase Update:

Dear Members,

Arrowhead Country Club has let us know that, due to rising food costs, the price of our monthly luncheon buffet will increase by \$5 beginning with the SEPTEMBER luncheon. The new price will be \$27 per person. This pricing covers the buffet, service fee, tax, and gratuity. We asked Arrowhead management if a smaller increase was possible, but they explained that the price adjustment was unavoidable and applies to all of Arrowhead's luncheon groups.

This price increase also affects a few related items:

- 1. New Member Welcome Gift New members who join will now receive a reusable canvas tote featuring the Newcomers logo, along with our newsletter, directory, and other welcome items. This gift replaces the former "free luncheon" offer and also helps raise our visibility in the community.
- 2. Standing Reservations Members with a "Standing Reservation" will be moved to "Will Call" if they are a "no-show," unless their absence is reported to Sandy Buchanan by 12:00 noon the Monday before the luncheon. As always, any confirmed "Will Call" member who is a "no-show" will be required to pay for her reservation.

We appreciate your understanding, as these changes reflect the same rising costs affecting us all. Thank you for your continued support of our luncheons and the Club.
