Proceedings

The Convergence was called to review the LSIRVM (Land Shark Incorporated Restorative Value Mediation) Foundational Stratagem and its integration with Building Futures Initiative and regional deployment objectives.

Shadow Sovereign presented strategic overview:

Regional Priority Framework was established: Primary focus on Milwaukee, Chicago, Detroit, Cleveland, Buffalo, with early 2026 expansion to Mexico, Kenya, and other strategically positioned countries. Geographic selection prioritizes inland cities near freshwater sources, avoiding coastline volatility.

Milwaukee Headquarters: The building designated as Obsidian Pinnacle is intended to serve as tether for all subsidiaries, hubs, and housing regarding resources and network scalability. Smaller investments necessary to establish positive recurring cash flow on books before major acquisition.

Cross-Border Strategy was outlined: Canadian permanent residency and dual citizenship pursued to build relationships and establish international flight and import corridors. Similar southern border strategy contemplated with consideration of climate volatility factors.

Climate Adaptation Analysis was presented: Midwest region positioning near Great Lakes provides approximately 20 additional years of livability based on climate projections. Strategic positioning near freshwater sources addresses anticipated water security concerns.

Corporate Network Scalability was discussed: Replication of dual citizenship pathway for employees throughout the Umbral Thread. Subsidiaries and trusts built out of wholesale profits. Thorncairn network infrastructure for cross-network connectivity.

Legal Framework Integration was reviewed: The expanded religious liberty precedents established by Christian nationalists have created significant latitude for organizational operations. The bidirectional nature of religious freedom protections serves the mission while maintaining legal compliance.

Safe Space Philosophy was articulated: Building safe spaces and communities with open doors. Not turning away enemies from good times, affordable housing, clean water, safe food, good education, modern convenience. Pirates give quarter—the foundational principle applies to all community members regardless of political alignment.

Brief contemplation arose regarding the tension between security and accessibility. After discussion of the principle that "more flies are caught with honey," consensus was reached that open-door policy serves both mission and strategic objectives.

#### Resolution

A motion was presented to adopt the following resolution:

Resolution in Affirmation of LSIRVM Foundational Stratagem and Regional Deployment Authorization

Vote conducted.

Result: Unanimous affirmative.

#### Outcome

The resolution was adopted and recognized as resolved for incorporation into Lex Imperium.


