

WHERE IS YOUR MIND SET?

Imagination: the act or power of forming a mental image of something not present to the senses or never before wholly perceived in reality; the part of your mind that allows you to form pictures or ideas of things that do not necessarily exist in real life.

<u>Fantasy</u>: the power or process of creating especially unrealistic or improbable mental images in response to psychological need

<u>Faith</u>: Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. (Hebrews 11:1 LSB)

NATURAL VS. SPIRITUAL (KEEP GROWING!)

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God, which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words.

But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT? AN OBJECT LESSON

When they came back to the disciples, they saw a large crowd around them, and some scribes arguing with them. Immediately, when the entire crowd saw Him, they were amazed and began running up to greet Him.

And He asked them, "What are you discussing with them?" And one of the crowd answered Him, "Teacher, I brought You my son, possessed with a spirit which makes him mute; and whenever it seizes him, it slams him to the ground and he foams at the mouth, and grinds his teeth and stiffens out. I told Your disciples to cast it out, and they could not do it."

And He answered them and said, "O unbelieving generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I put up with you? Bring him to Me!"

They brought the boy to Him. When he saw Him, immediately the spirit threw him into a convulsion, and falling to the ground, he began rolling around and foaming at the mouth.

And He asked his father, "How long has this been happening to him?" And he said, "From childhood.

THE AUTHORITY IS IN THE IDENTITY

"It has often thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, take pity on us and help us!"

And Jesus said to him, "'If You can?' All things are possible to him who believes."

Immediately the boy's father cried out and said, "I do believe; help my unbelief."

When Jesus saw that a crowd was rapidly gathering, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, "You deaf and mute spirit, I command you, come out of him and do not enter him again."

After crying out and throwing him into terrible convulsions, it came out; and the boy became so much like a corpse that most of them said, "He is dead!"

But Jesus took him by the hand and raised him; and he got up.

When He came into the house, His disciples began questioning Him privately, "Why could we not drive it out?"

And He said to them, "This kind cannot come out by anything but prayer."

Mark 9:22-29 NASB

WHY COULD WE NOT DRIVE IT OUT?

- There is always a need for greater (and fresh) faith
 - Both the Disciples and the boy's father
- Jesus' answer didn't focus on procedure
 - They didn't say the wrong words or perform an incorrect ritual
- Their past successes had given them confidence in their own abilities
- Jesus calls them to more prayer—greater dependence on God
- Our authority is mediated authority
- We must have 100% dependence on the one who has "disarmed the powers and authorities...triumphing over them by the cross," (Colossians 2:15) as well as discernment and humility.

Doing great things for God means seeking His guidance, being led by the Spirit, and allowing <u>His</u> power to work *through* us daily.

GO DEEPER – LOST SOULS DEPENDS ON IT!

"I tell you that He will bring about justice for them quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find that faith on the earth?"


