



# AN IMPORTANT DISTINCTION

Now the serpent was the most cunning of all the wild animals that the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You can't eat from any tree in the garden'?"

The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit from the trees in the garden. But about the fruit of the tree in the middle of the garden, God said, 'You must not eat it or touch it, or you will die.'"

#### WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM?

Serpent: "God" - Elohim

- gods (plural); those in supreme authority over you who exercise complete authority over you; divine majesty and power
- Not to be reasoned with; containing higher unattainable wisdom
- Aspect of Supreme Judge

Bible to Man: "LORD" - YHWH Elohim

- Focuses on Aspect of Mercy, but with the power to judge
- "Tetragrammaton" "I am"

#### WHAT SHOULD I TELL THEM?

Then Moses asked God, "If I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your ancestors has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what should I tell them?"

God replied to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM., This is what you are to say to the Israelites: I AM has sent me to you."

God also said to Moses, "Say this to the Israelites: The LORD, the God of your ancestors, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is my name forever; this is how I am to be remembered in every generation.

# JESUS: TRUTH OVER TRADITION

And He closed the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down, and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him. And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

And all were speaking well of Him and marveling at the gracious words which were coming forth from His lips, and they were saying, "Is this not Joseph's son?"

Torah: "To Hit the Mark"


Aka, "The loving instructions of the Father"


Sin/Transgression: "To Miss the Mark"

# OUR AUTHORITY IS IN OUR IDENTITY

Exousia: Authority to do something; the potential to command, control, or govern; the freedom to choose wisely and soberly without false influence

# AUTHORITY IS THE POWER OF CHOICE

You adulterous people! Don't you know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? So whoever wants to be the friend of the world becomes the enemy of God. Or do you think it's without reason that the Scripture says: The spirit he made to dwell in us envies intensely?,

But he gives greater grace. Therefore he says: God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble.,

Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Be miserable and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom.

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.

James 4:4–10 CSB

# HE IS COMING AGAIN – IN JUDGEMENT

# AUTHORITY IS THE POWER OF CHOICE

- To those who believe in Jesus, who HE says He is, and in His completed work, grace releases in them the authority to reject the kingdom of darkness
- To be in the world but not of the world is to walk in the Spirit, living according to the Kingdom of Light
- Grace begins as a buffer, a "hedge" of protection to give you options
- Abiding---staying planted, being still---is the source of our strength
