



And I, brothers, was not able to speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to fleshly men, as to infants in Christ. I gave you milk to drink, not solid food, for you were not yet able to receive it. Indeed, even now you are still not able, for you are still fleshly.

For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking blike mere men? For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," are you not mere men?

What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, even as the Lord gave to each one. I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth. So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth.

Now he who plants and he who waters are one, but each will receive his own reward according to his own labor. For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's bfield, God's building. According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it.

GRACE (CHARIS) AS USED BY PAUL

Mercy, Kindness, Power

- God's Presence (Joy, Fullness of Life, Favor) Rom 5:1-2
 - God opened a doorway to peace
- God's Calling (Set apart for Purpose) Gal 1:15/Eph 3:2
 - He freely gave and we are expected to do the same
- God's Power (Charismata; power to fulfill) 1 Cor 12
 - Free gifts of power to accomplish the work as His witnesses

"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do because I go to the Father."

GRACE (CHARIS) AS USED BY JESUS

"Give to everyone who asks of you, and whoever takes away what is yours, do not demand it back. And treat others the same way you want them to treat you.

And if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same.

GRACE (ELEOS), MERCY

- Acts of kindness toward the sick and afflicted, joined with a desire to help them
- Implies action
- God towards us, and us toward others
- A state of clemency whereas gifts are given, though not deserved

Therefore let's approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace for help at the time of our need.

• (Paul's thorn in the flesh)
