The Foundation of Excellence

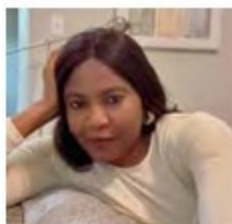
We owe so much to our first principal, the late Mr. David Akintola, a visionary leader who transformed the school into a center of excellence. Under his firm but fatherly leadership, the

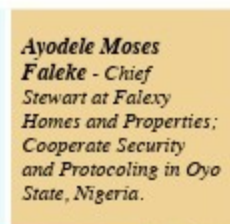

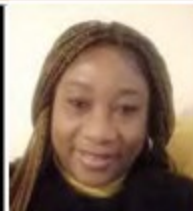

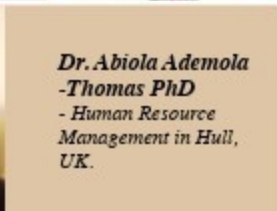
