T.O. OPENING REMARKS – Dec 14, 2025 (1233 words = 9.8 minutes)

Welcome to the 84th monthly meeting of *Making Waves for Democracy*! Today is the first day of Hanukkah...Despite the anti-Semitic mass shooting in Australia, we will light the first candle tonight!
