Now that we have heard from Senator Min the next opportunity to support him is coming up **next Saturday morning, May 4 in Huntington Beach or Irvine**. We hope to see you there.

This area has an interesting past. Over the past 20 years redistricting has moved the lines closer to the traditionally conservative coastal areas and yet Democrats keep winning. Both Hilary and President Biden won here. The demographics for the area are shifting away from traditional Reagan Republicans. There is a growing API and Hispanic population, 1/3 foreign born and 45% speaking a language other than English in the home.

The election in March leaned purple with the number living In Irvine and Laguna much larger than those in Huntington Beach and Newport Beach - a good sign for November if we can get youth, non-white and women to show up. Sen Min's record lines up: working on legislation supporting access to healthcare for women, reducing gun violence and protecting the environment. And he's endorsed by police, firefighters, teachers unions, Planned Parenthood and NARAL.

Meanwhile, his opponent Scott Baugh promises to support a nationwide abortion ban, opposes same sex marriage and describes immigrants as drug pushers and criminals.
