Terminating care for trans kids... in the middle of their treatments... It's traumatizing.

A trans onetime colleague of mine is seriously considering leaving the country because she is afraid of her rights continuing to vanish, even in CA

There are fewer and fewer states we can feel comfortable traveling to (or spending money in).

I worry that anti-affirmative action is part of not teaching history and pretending racism does not exist

As an immigrant, this is not the country I signed up for.

The website decision opened up many different types of cases to restrict gay rights.

I worry about the parents, and friends of girls needing support

I am not affected personally, but I grew up in communist and fascist Romania and came here eventually to this county for FREEDOM, and to see what's happening to it is heartbreaking.

So many young people with crushing student debt already struggling during the pause in debt repayment.

Abortions and especially the girls.

I actually think there is a way around the affirmative action decision: admit first generation students, whose parents didn't go to college. There are no constitutional barriers against class discrimination.
