This is the most important election of my lifetime. I imagine many of you would say the same.

Despite reading Sinclair's Lewis's novel "It Can't Happen Here" when I was a kid, I never really digested the reality that <u>it could and it is</u> <u>happening here</u>. Our democracy is under threat and attack—and only **WE** can protect it.

I have taken Torie's mantra to heart: "ACTION IS THE ANTIDOTE TO DESPAIR". NOW, MORE THAN EVER is a crucial time to step up! WE MUST REGAIN CONTROL OF THE HOUSE.

With all that in mind, I am asking **YOU** to **JOIN ME** as a **Co-Host** for our final fundraiser of this election cycle. This is a fundraiser for Democratic Congressional candidates Dave Min (CA-47) – Katie Porter's district, and George Whitesides CA-27) MAGA George Garcia's current district. The fundraiser will be a virtual event held on Zoom, September 15, from 4-5 p.m.

How did I or others do it – we were polite though persistent, shared our deep concern for our Democracy, reached out to all we knew who might be interested, and took it on with determination because **the road to a Blue Congressional House moves through California.** With our help, we can make sure both of these seats are held by Democrats.

Here is how Co-hosting works!

Co-hosts commit to donating or raising at least \$500. A co-host can donate that amount themselves, they can reach out to out to their family, friends, colleagues, and acquaintances, asking them to buy a \$50 ticket to the event, and they certainly can do both! Raising \$500 means selling just ten of these tickets—often less because many people donate more.

That's it!

Think for a minute about how many people <u>you</u> know who would be willing to donate \$50 to help regain the house majority. You know lots of people who <u>feel the need in these dire times to do more</u>, therefore lots of people who would contribute.
