## **Protecting Water Quality**

is the responsibility of all those who live, work, and visit the watershed.

Farmers practice soil conservation by using minimum tillage, growing cover crops, using only necessary fertilizers, pesticides, and buffer strips between fields and drainage ways.

Homeowners must ensure that their on-site waste disposal systems are installed properly. Absorb rainwater through lawns and gardens while keeping it away from sewer systems via water gardens, rain barrels and other water conservation practices. Clear downed trees from the creek.

They are safety hazards for the paddlers, causing water to back up and flood low-lying areas.

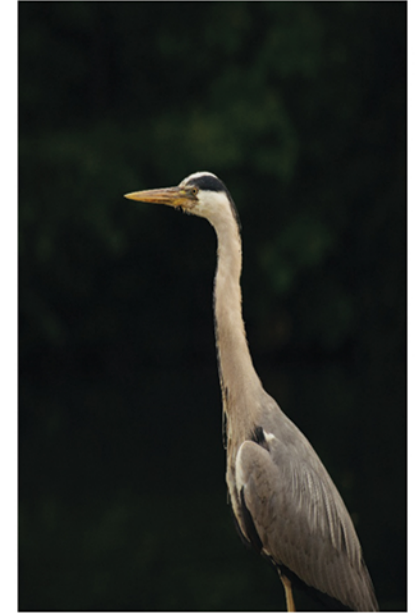
