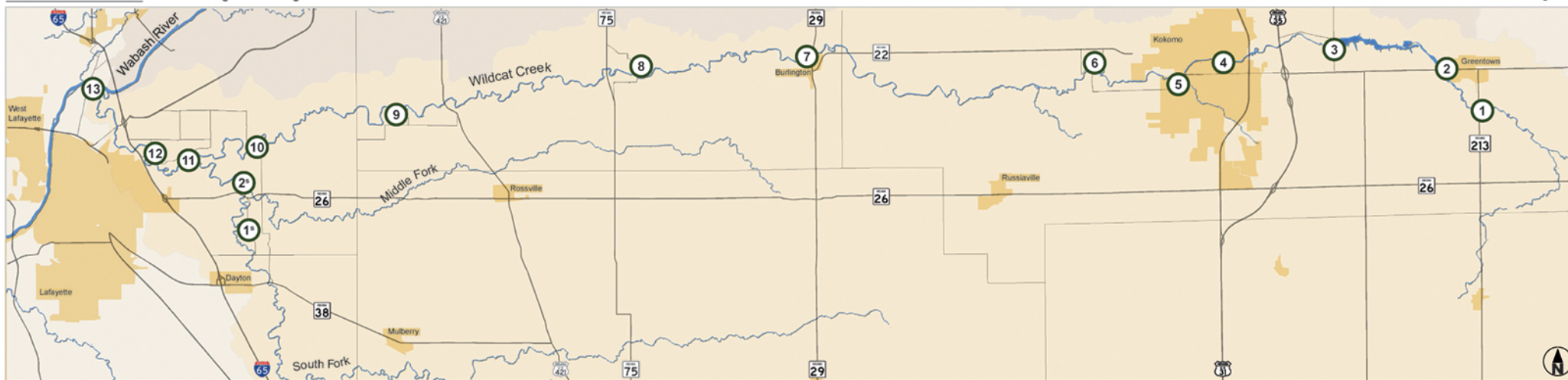


Wildcat Creek - Public Access Locations

1. Pe-Che-Wah - PAS

Address - 1491 SR-213 Greentown, IN 46936
Directions - Creek access on the northwest side of the SR 213 bridge

2. Greentown Boat Club

Address - W Main St. Greentown, IN 46936
Directions - Public access on the southeast side of the US 35 bridge

3. Kokomo Reservoir Boat Ramp

Address - 908 N 400 E Kokomo, Indiana 46901
Directions - Public boat launch on north end of dam. Can portage at spillway

4. Waterworks Park

Address - 1227 E Carter St. Kokomo, IN 46901
Directions - Creek access with paved ramp

5. Steel Mill - PAS

Address - 1425 S Park Avenue Kokomo, IN 46902
Directions - Creek access downstream of Markland Avenue Bridge

6. Yeoman Bridge - PAS

Address - 10 S 440 W Kokomo, IN 46901
Directions - Creek access on left bank upstream of the 440 W bridge

7. Burlington - PAS

Address - 404 W Arvin Dr. Burlington, IN 46920
Directions - Creek access downstream of SR 29 bridge

8. Adam's Mill

Address - 4640 S 75 E Cutler, IN 46920
Directions - Historic mill site with creek access and parking across road from mill

9. Knop Lake - PFS

Address - 7491 W 650 S Rossville, IN 46065
Directions - 50 acre park with small lake. Creek access on left bank via paved ramp. Near Pymont

10. Mi-So-La Landing

Address - 1850 N 725 E Lafayette, IN 47905
Directions - Creek access downstream of 725 E bridge

11. Wildcat Park

Address - 5277 Eisenhower Rd Lafayette, IN 47905
Directions - 53 acre park located on Eisenhower Rd about 2 miles from Peter's Mill

12. Peter's Mill Landing

Address - 1555 Eisenhower Ct Lafayette, IN 47905
Directions - Creek access downstream of Eisenhower Rd bridge

13. Davis Ferry Park

Address - N 9th St Lafayette, IN 47904
Directions - Creek access is southeast of N 9th St bridge

Directions - South fork access downstream of 200 S bridge

Creek Safety

PLAN WISELY: Before your water activity on the Wildcat Creek closely examine the map above and ensure you have a safe entry and exit from the creek.
PACK A LIFE JACKET: Wear a properly fitted US Coast Guard Approved life jacket based on your weight and size.
DRESS APPROPRIATELY: Wear a life jacket, proper foot wear, sunglasses and bring enough sun screen or UV protective clothes and water to enjoy your trip on the creek.
FOLLOW ROUTE: Follow the route of the creek and please respect private properties and use public landings only.

WEATHER AWARENESS: Be aware of changing weather conditions prior to your water activity. Rainfall a few days prior to your water activity can change the water flow and level to make the creek conditions more hazardous. Check with local weather reports before your trip.
STEWARDSHIP: Be a steward of the Wildcat Creek by placing your trash in boat launch site trash containers and follow leave no trace principles. Leave the creek better than you found it.
SHARE WITH OTHERS: Let a trusted relative or friend know of your water activity. To include your intended return time and location. In the event of an emergency, a friend can share this information with emergency services looking for you.
CALL 911: In an emergency, call 911 and be prepared to share your location on the Wildcat Creek in relation to the named public landings.
