I did it as quick as I could. guest who is joining us today from El Salvador is Dr. Jack Cruz, a neurosurgeon, a health educator, and the founder of the Cruz Longevity Center in Destin, Florida. Renowned for his pioneering work in quantum biology, circadian biology, and evolutionary medicine, he emphasizes the critical role of light, water, and magnetism in optimizing health and longevity. Over the past several years, Dr. Cruz has shifted from conventional centralized medicine to advocate for decentralized health and biohacking. Aligning lifestyle with natural rhythms to reverse chronic diseases, his blog is jackcruise.com; he has over 250,000 monthly visitors. He is on X at. I did have it up. Yes, he is on X at. Dr. Jack Cruz, thank you so much for joining us today, Dr. Cruz. Thank you. Glad to be here. Amazing. So where do we even begin?

[00:06:19] I think you should begin with his expertise talking about light because this has been fascinating to see. Sure, sure. Coming out on X.

[00:06:27] I've been watching some of your interviews. I guess I want to start with blue light because we have over at The Backlash so much exposure to blue light. I have some blue light glasses, but outside of that, I mean, I'm not really doing very much to protect myself. blue light makes us dumb. If we could start there, if you could talk a little bit about blue light and why it's affecting us negatively, how it's affecting us negatively, that would be a great start.

Jack Kruse

[00:06:53] Modern life has replaced the sun with blue light. Technology fundamentally brings you inside. The effect of blue light is multifocal and varied. What does it do? It increases your blood sugar and your insulin without you eating food. It also destroys your DHA levels that come from seafood. On your inner mitochondrial, I should say your outer mitochondrial membrane and all the membranes in you so that you can't accurately tell time. It affects your melatonin level, which also affects your ability to tell time, also hinders your ability to fight inflammation. And it actually causes you to get older, where it affects your ability to think. Um, when dopamine and melatonin are impacted by blue light, there's a central retinal pathway in your eye that goes into your brain. It has no synapses. It goes to two places. One I've already covered, which is the suprachiasmatic nucleus, which is the clock that controls everything in your body. But the second relay center is the habenular nucleus, which controls your frontal lobes. And that's how you get dumbed down.

[00:08:04] Could you talk a little bit about light stability issues and how people that are from northern latitudes, like me, not like you with your Italian blood, how we can deal with that? I've heard you talk about embracing cold and waking up to see the sunrise. It's light here until 9:30 now.

[00:08:28] And it gets light at like 4:30 in the morning.

[00:08:30] Right, right, right. So do we just soak it up while we can in the summer? And then embrace the cold in the winter? Or do you think that we desperately need to get out of this climate for about three months a year?

Jack Kruse

[00:08:42] Well, I mean, it depends. In the old days, it was easy to overcome light stability problems because people would get up and go to bed with the light cycles. These days, that doesn't happen. So, the answer. Especially if you have a mitochondrial disease. You're probably better off going to a light-stable area. For those who don't know, light stability is built inside the tropics. We're not at 20° North or 20° South, which are the Tropic of Capricorn and Tropic of Cancer; you only lose about 30 to 45 minutes as you get to the summer or winter solstice. So that builds the stability. Anything above that, you're obviously losing more light. Why is that important? Because when you have light stability, you're able to build a much easier template for your circadian life. So this is the reason why. Uh, many of the autoimmune conditions that you hear about, like MS, ALS, things like that are much more prominent outside the tropics. Uh, it's also the reason why SAD, which you know was probably popularized through the rock movement with Janis Joplin, Jimi Hendrix, Kurt Cobain, and the rest of them that killed themselves. Most people, I think, know that SAD is a huge problem at high latitudes, so much so that places like Scandinavia are now putting mirrors in their downtown towns to shine light into them to try to give people more light at the winter solstice, you know, around December 20th, 21st. And when you begin to understand that and you understand that technology, which we've embraced tremendously since 1960, has brought this blue light inside. It's also brought us inside. Then you have to make a determination. I would say if you don't have any significant mitochondrial injuries or mitochondrial illness, you could probably stay where you are and use the old school way of doing it. Like the Sherpas did-embrace the cold, and the light changes as long as you're living in nature. But most of you don't do that. And when you, you're okay to lie to me, you're okay to lie to people on Twitter, but you should never lie to yourself. And if you lie to yourself, ultimately you're going to wind up with the mitochondrial problem. And mitochondrial problems, they're fixable, but for some people, they're very difficult to fix. And they become much more difficult if you have an uncoupled haplotype and you live in a place where there's no light stability. Why? Because most people are not willing to do the things that nature requires them to do.

[00:11:26] Right. I've actually, I heard at your Bitcoin Prague talk, you were recommending that people switch to candlelight again. Yeah. For the infrared benefits.

Jack Kruse

[00:11:36] That would be a big hack for people that live at high latitude. And that one is kind of easy. I will tell you, it's a little bit more difficult. In a place like El Salvador, because we don't have candles. And this brings up a very interesting kind of point. I've mentioned to my members that if you have a significant mitochondrial disease, like say ALS, they don't even have handicap cars and wheelchairs for you. Why? Because no one gets ALS there. And this is like a shocking revelation. You know, for people who live in Minneapolis or Toronto or Vancouver, because people are used to seeing people, you know, with MS, depression, SAD, things like that. The diseases that people get. Inside the tropics are radically different than the diseases that you see in modern America or modern Europe. And that has implications. You know, for people. And I think just getting that realization that every single disease is reversible, but not every patient is because they're not willing to understand that they are thread in the fabric of nature if you're if you think that you're somehow different than the wolves in Yellowstone Park? You're out of your fucking mind.

[00:13:17] By the way, which blew my mind because I'm like, 'Thank God we're finally starting to integrate the nationalist community and the Bitcoin community and this like health, you know, health-conscious aspect that's been all interconnected.' Well, it's starting to get interconnected. This has been.

Jack Kruse

[00:13:33] Yeah, I would agree with that. I think it's just starting. I don't think it is interconnected. I think Bitcoiners are some of the most disconnected people on the planet. They get it on the money side, but they don't get it on the health side. And that's why I went to Prague last year and used three specific guys, three of their heroes – uh, used a hardware guy, software guy, and a bitcoin um cypherpunk, Hal Finney. I said, what good is it, you know, being a billionaire, you know, at 60 years old if you're dead? And, you know, it brings up kind of an interesting topic that's current events because he just did a pretty controversial interview. When Peter Thiel was asked a question, Peter Thiel happens to be. You know, one of those I wouldn't call him a cypherpunk, but I would call him a technologist; he's a transhumanist and he is cut uh from the same cloth as the three guys that I used last year,

which was Jobs, Paul Allen, and Hal Finney. And what people don't really understand is Teal is the opposite of those three guys where he has always been focused on longevity, but his focus in on longevity has been through what I would call the dark side of centralized medicine, which is. The side that I think is dominated by people like Uberman, Peter Attia. Um, Ray Kurzweil and you know when you really nail it down. These are all people that came from a guy's mindset named Brock Pierce; Brock Pierce was a Bitcoin futurist and he was a founder of Tether. And blockchain capital, he's actually pretty tied in with Adam Back. And a lot of Bitcoiners don't know, you know, this story. And Brock Pierce, the reason why this is critical for bitcoiners and you know, the technologists to understand because you have to know the history: he attended uh, a group called Mindshift, and he was Jeffrey Epstein's initial advisor on all things crypto. And when you actually know this history, you begin to go, 'Wait a minute. Is this how the bankers, the technologists, the transhumanists...' The Bitcoiners kind of all um came together between you know 96 and 2008 in this what I would like to call you know a spaghetti sauce pot. And then eventually out of that chaos, some order came and then you started to see sides. Um, manifest the problem is since so many people don't really understand truly how decentralized health and wealth are fundamentally linked and tied to the major players that are involved. You know, right now in politics, I think there's a lot of misconceptions. You know, in fact, I've said this many other podcasts-that many people listen to what Whitney Webb says and her partner Godwin and take it as gospel. And I don't. I don't think they've got the diagnosis down at all. They've got a lot right, but not all of it right. And most of the stuff they have wrong is when they understand what the two sides are. Like I've tried to give people the history. Um, with a guy named Bull Warg, a death metal guy, and then I gave more with Breed Love about the history of pre-Bitcoin with Meyerslansky with the Israelis, how the bankers first got informed that fiat money had to be blown up and why they had to come to CBDC. Most Bitcoiners, though, their focus, and you really heard this at Jack Mulder's redo video in Prague. And, in case people don't know, that video was redone. His investors in 21 didn't like the first iteration of the talk, which was done on the first day of the event, which I found kind of interesting. Really?

[00:18:15] But obviously the people that are involved in 21 are all industry people and they're tied to this kind of the story that we're. You know, forming right now, and I thought

the talk that Jack gave the first day was spot on; it was actually very accurate. But the people who are behind this Bitcoin holding company didn't like it too much. From what I understand, Jack was already outside of Prague; he was gone. And they brought him back on the last day. He was the last person that spoke on the final day. Because his people wanted him to give a different version of the talk. And the version of the talk that you heard – obviously – it resonates with me and my tribe. Why? Because, really what Jack was talking about was time and decentralized time. But what he did is he took apart a lot of the stuff. That I'm sharing with you in the beginning about how this all started, how Epstein, Thiel, Elon Musk are tied with Adam Back that maybe Adam Back and Michael Saylor aren't. Who we really think, and that we as decentralized savages have to look at the history of events as they unfold. It doesn't mean these people are nefarious or bad. And I'm speaking specifically about Saylor and Back but I need you to know how they're linked to this whole story so that when you understand like the change that Saylor made a year ago at Bitcoin Prime, Bitcoin Prague, when he said that, you know. Bitcoin doesn't really need to be a money. It doesn't have to be. Um, you know, custodied by the individual. It can be custodied by banks and that we should consider leverage. Realize he's talking now as a CEO of strategy. Because he's got 550,000 Bitcoin. That is not who your audience is made of. Your audience is made of savages, just like my tribe is made of savages, where a loyalty title has to be protected. And Bitcoin should be thought of as money, not just the time value of money, not like digital gold. And when you really parse the story out, why he's beginning to say some of the stuff, it takes you all the way back, you know, to this beginning part of the story at the MindShift conference. And I don't believe people know how MIT Media Labs was tied into this story, how OpenEye Media and OpenAI were involved in this. Mozilla was interested in it, so was Microsoft. And the people that were involved, you know, like Reed Hoffman, the PayPal Mafia guys, the Peter Teals-these guys are all linked together at this time. And what's happened since then, they've all fractured apart. Now they all have their own, how shall I say, Bitcoin DNA code. And I guess what I want Bitcoiners to understand is I want you to know who your friends and your enemies are. Uh, remember my day job is as a neurosurgeon-the one thing I can tell you that I'm expert at is making diagnoses. You give me the thermodynamic givens and I'll go back and do a deep dive on the history, and begin to put it together. And come on podcasts when I'm asked the appropriate questions and tell you what I think you need to be aware of going forward. And ultimately, my two cents on the Bitcoin side is pretty simple: I'm trying to create decentralized savers so that they can create generational wealth, so they can change their light stability. They can build a citadel to save the normies in their life that are fucking idiots that they decide to save down the road. And the mindset that's being built right now in these Bitcoin holding companies. While I think it's good. If you're a company or you're a shareholder of these companies, if you're an individual decentralized savage, many of the things that are being talked about in their talks, in their podcasts. They are not. How shall I say part of your DNA? That is their zip code. Their zip code will benefit you, but make no mistake – that you need to capture a lawyer title with self-custody. If you're a Bitcoiner who listens to this and think that putting your money with Fidelity, Schwab, Goldman Sachs is a good idea like Michael Saylor has been kind of telling us now for 13 months, in my opinion, you're a fucking idiot.

[00:23:45] Let me interject here because this is important. Do I think? Like what I talked about at Bitcoin Prague this year, because I know you guys haven't heard it yet. I haven't released.

[00:23:57] I don't think it's been released. There's a pirated version that I was able to dig up on the Internet because I'm like, I cannot talk to Uncle Jack unless I've listened to his conference. Sorry.

Jack Kruse

[00:24:06] I think any time you sell your Bitcoin, as long as you're using it to put time in your bank account, it's a good thing. So that being said, if you're putting time. Back into your bank account um in your citadel I'm okay with that now. The interesting thing is, you guys started this podcast with some bullshit going on in your fucking locale; I don't even know about it, but I could give two fucks about it. But that really goes to this issue: it tells me that her purchase was not wise, why because uh, if you are in a place where you can actively be shot in fact, if I'm not mistaken, verbatim she said, 'I laid down with my gun and waited to see what was going to happen.' Let me explain something to you: That is fragility. That is not anti-fragility. And you need to realize that if you could be taken out because your local environment isn't safe, then you have to question. You know, your decision was selling my Bitcoin, wise or not. And this is, you know, you guys are laughing about this, but you notice I'm not laughing. I'm being very, very serious about this. That one of the big things about a loyal title is that you need to protect your time. And when you get in front of that mirror. And you're lying to everybody else and lying to the people on the podcast, realize to yourself, say, 'Am I really doing the right thing by me and the people who rely on me to do this?' Because I'm going to tell you, for me, this was a huge big deal because in the beginning I thought I was going to go to Florida. Then I thought I was going to go to Mexico. And then what eventually

happened? I settled on the most unsafe country in the world. And if you think about that for a minute, you go, God, that sounds totally crazy. But what did I do? I put my decentralized thinking hat on and realized what Bukele was really doing. And what happened after? And people don't remember this history. Bitcoin became legal tender in El Salvador because of Jack Miller's and Bukele's efforts, before the exception regime comes in, before he takes the bad hombres out. So realize what that means to me as a diagnostician: Kelly, the politician, is doing something so unlike a politician. He's returning freedom back to his people. Then what does he do? Literally, backs it up within four to six weeks of putting the exception regime and that is what you guys all know as 'CCT' -putting the bad guys away. Literally, El Salvador goes from the most unsafe country in the world to the safest country in the world literally in two to three months. So, of course I'm down there when all this is going on, and I look at my son, I look at my nurse. And she even says to me, 'This place is better than Mexico, isn't it?' I'm like, 'Yeah.' And I said, 'This is a change. This is something I got to put.' Into you know my diagnostic equation, and what did I do? I literally pulled the trigger, And bought a piece of property there immediately. Now, did I build out on it, this, and that? No, because I was still concerned. Was the timing right? Was I too early? Do I need to see this develop? I did. And then when I saw everything developed, I did something even more crazy. I actually bought a citadel, a true citadel. And I still have the original piece of property that I bought. My family now has this whole thing built out; the normies and the friends around me. I brought them there, and I told them, 'I said, This right here. I think for the next 20 years, we're safe.' I don't believe that we're safe. In the Citadel that I had built in the United States. In fact, all the Citadels in Florida sold and bought Bitcoin with it. The Citadel in Louisiana also on the market, ready to be sold. Um, I am no longer of the belief after what's gone on with Bobby Kennedy and Maha. That I think the United States is safe at all. I view the United States as safe for maybe five or 10 years, but it's eventually going to wind up just like continental Europe. Uh, Canada and Australia, why because the government is doing very much opposite what Bukele did, they are stealing your time through every single aspect that they can, and this highlights the reason why I kind of rebuked your co-host. She experienced it last night, yeah, and the thing is if she doesn't make an accurate diagnosis about this, she's telling me early that she's got little kids running around, I gotta be honest with you, um. She's going to be one of those ladies on X, that's crying because somebody put a bullet in her kid's head. And you know what? I'm going to fucking write the tweet and say compliance.

We're going to worship God the way we want. We're not going to pay taxes. They were the foreigners in the land, but why was it okay at our genesis? And you're fucking telling me in 2025 that it's not. Maybe you're the one with the problem. Maybe your audience is the one with the problem. Because guess what? What's going on in the government right now is far worse than what went on in 1770 through 1774. And if you argue that point, I will fucking deconstruct your argument from the get-go.

The first question that I have, because I love what Nayib Bukele has done. I've been following him on X ever since he came to power. He's the son of Palestinian refugees, right? Correct me if I'm wrong. It's true, and he's married to a Christian. Yes, and when you look at his government, the government buildings, he's got pictures of Catholic priests. You know, he always gives glory to God. I'm a Catholic. We're both Catholic. And so, you know, that's important. My condolences. It's okay. I totally understand where you're coming from. We've had our fair share of problems, CIA getting involved, you know, all of this liberation theology, the whole thing. But with what has been going on with Seacott, obviously great thing for the people of El Salvador, but there have been a lot of things that I've kind of noticed, like Donald Trump, for example, you know, deporting this guy, Mahmoud Khalil, or at least attempting to deport him for speaking out on what is happening in Gaza. And the talk of the town was that he was going to get deported to Sicily. I've got a friend, an Iranian Jew, who has been, you know, begging me to be careful because he thinks I'm going to get deported to Sicily. And there are some significant ties between the new state that Bukele has been building Israel. So can you help enlighten us and our audience? Is there any connection or chance that El Salvador is being turned into essentially an Israeli penal colony? Is Nayib Bukele captured by the Zionists?

[00:32:30] No, not even close. In fact, I would tell you it's much more likely the other side of the equation, that his closest ties right now are probably to Trump's administration. But I will warn you, this is very recent. However, the big tie is to Qatar. Qatar and Turkey have huge impacts. Prior to Bukele, Communist China was big through FMLN in El Salvador. Uh, what did uh Bukele do? For those of your audience who don't know, one of the baller moves he did was a big, huge um metal statue in El Salvador that three and a half years ago, but Kelly melted down to make um new hubcaps for the roads, and he said that's that's what I feel about communism, and that we need to return freedom back to people. Israel has really nothing to do with local politics at all. There are a lot of Jews that are in El Salvador, but they were here prior to Bukele ever coming to power. The Jews that are in El Salvador now are secular Jews. They're not Zionists. Remember, one needs to separate the Jews from the Zionists, because if you don't do that. I believe that you're making a diagnostic error. Because the Zionists are linked through the Balfour Declaration, are tied to the bankers. And

remember that El Salvador doesn't have a central bank. They actually use American money. And this is the reason why the Bitcoin story is so powerful because Bukele is the first leader that brought Bitcoin onto the scene. Why did he do that? He's actually done what Trump is telling you and your audience that he's trying to do. He's trying to protect the U. S. treasury market to make sure that the hegemony of the U. S. dollar last another 50 to 75 years. Bukele did the same thing. Bitcoin was, the, how shall we say, insurance policy for Salvadorians that didn't own any Bitcoin at the time. Why? Because think about it. If American money goes boom, any dollarized economy goes big time boom. And the difference is cats like you and your co-host. Uh, if the Raw Charles and Rockefellers win, you'll get a CBDC so they'll just convert all your American money to the Bis money. You think that's going to happen in El Salvador? The answer is no, so he has to have this backdrop. And that's the reason why I started the podcast with you from a diagnostic standpoint to understand what it meant for a politician to give his people freedom and money. Why? Because, in Bitcoin parlance, you heard it in Prague, you fix the money, you fix the world. And most Bitcoiners believe that. We clearly know that Bukele is a Bitcoiner. What we now have, both on the right and the left in the United States, are people who are not freedom maximus. For example, Trump and the technocrats, they are freedom maximus for money, but not for surveillance. Therefore, they're not our friends.
