## STUDENTS FOR YE

Six and a half months ago, I became your first student supporter when you demanded that our former President's subsequent policies be held accountable to the standard set forth by God in the Bible. As such, we did so ourselves and eagerly await the opportunity to point out volunteers to your official campaign when you launch. I cannot wait to campaign for you! Students for Ye formed a youth organization with several chapters and over 10,000 supporters. After the betrayal of my fellow co-founder (who you met), I became Chairman of the organization and set the goal of creating an all-volunteer army of 100,000 students who are willing to lay down their lives for Jesus Christ and the campaign.

As Christians, and especially me as a baby Christian, we all fall short of the perfect standard set by Jesus during His life and ministry. The conduct and lifestyle of Mr. Yiannopoulos, however, do not reflect the faith, or the pursuit of charity, similar to any upstanding Christian I have ever known, nor are they consubstantial with the goals of Students for Ye.

Because Mr. Yiannopoulos makes so many young students feel uncomfortable, none of our students will work for/with him. Concerned parents have already called. We cannot lawfully give him files anyway. When your campaign starts, we will roll our organization into your campaign or form a Super PAC—whatever you desire and is lawful. So long as your testimony and walk in Christianity continues, you will have my unwavering support and loyalty.
