BOARDING WITH THE BUTLERS

Our dogs are our family members, and we hope your dog becomes a beloved extended family member and enjoys his/her time with us. Keeping your dog safe, healthy, and happy are our paramount concerns.

We have crates and beds for boarders, but you are welcome to bring your dog's crate and bedding for his/her comfort. Your dog will have free access to our entire home and all furniture under our supervision. We do not crate the dogs when we are at home unless absolutely necessary (such as when the housekeepers are here). When we are not at home and at bedtime, all dogs are crated with access to water. For safety reasons we do not leave collars, clothes, bows, etc. on dogs when they are in crates.

Kindly provide us with food for your dog sufficient to last their entire stay. Your dog will be fed his/her meals in the crate. If we run out of food prior to your return, we will feed your dog an appropriate quantity of Purina Pro Plan Adult Sensitive Stomach Salmon and Rice kibble. Each dog also receives a treat at bedtime, typically Fruitables or Charlee Bear cookies. Otherwise, treats are doled out sparingly, although our dogs occasionally get blueberries, apples, carrots, and tuna to supplement their kibble. We will NOT give any human food to your dog without your express permission. We will give any treats you provide to your dog only unless you specify that sharing is permissible.

Kindly also provide us with an adequate supply of any medications or supplements your dog will need during his/her stay, including heartworm and flea/tick prevention medicines. Otherwise, we will give your dog Sentinel or Heartgard Plus for heartworm prevention and Vectra topical for fleas/ticks on the first and fifteenth of the month respectively and bill you accordingly.

Since we both currently work from home, the dogs spend most of their time indoors with us. The dogs are given regular unsupervised access to our fully fenced backyard for recreation and pottying purposes. We do NOT leave the dogs unsupervised outside for longer than fifteen (15) minutes at a time, nor do we allow them to go in and out of the front door or in the front yard without being leashed and supervised. We ask that you provide us with a snug-fitting collar or harness with current tags and a fabric or leather leash (6' maximum length). We NEVER use retractable leashes as they can injure your dog and other people and animals. If your dog enjoys leashed walks, we will gladly take them on jaunts around our neighbourhood. However, we will NOT take your dogs to any human or dog parks or around strangers and their dogs nor will we allow them to walk off-leash. Depending on his/her comfort level, your dog may interact with adult human visitors to our home. If s/he is uncomfortable with visitors, we will crate him/her in the dog room or confine him/her to a secure playpen. For liability reasons, we do NOT allow any children to interact with our boarding dogs.

We have a selection of soft toys, balls, beds, and blankets for the amusement of all dogs. You are free to bring your dog's own toys/comfort objects, but we cannot guarantee that our dogs will stay away from them or that they will remain in good condition. Please do NOT send any expensive or irreplaceable items with your dog.

We regularly brush and comb all of the dogs in between baths and grooming sessions. We may bathe and groom your dog during his/her stay as needed for hygiene and safety. We will NOT take your dog to a commercial groomer. We also will NOT shave your dog or clip his/her coat, although we may cut out tight mats, cut their nails, and/or trim the underside of their paws for safety.

In case of any medical problem, we will attempt to contact you immediately and will try to take your dog to his/her regular veterinarian for prompt treatment. In emergent situations, we may take your dog to West Alabama Animal Clinic, Watermark Veterinary Hospital, or Brittmoore Animal Hospital (our dogs' veterinarians) or an appropriate specialist/emergency clinic (such as Sugar Land Veterinary Specialists). **By signing below, you authorize us to consent to medical treatment for your dog and agree to reimburse us in full for any veterinary charges we incur on behalf of your dog.**

At the time of dropoff, we will arrange a pickup date and time. Please advise us immediately of any changes to your plans (e.g., flight delays). We will wash your dog's toys, clothes, and bedding prior to departure and return any remaining food, medicine, and treats. We will also bathe and groom your dog prior to his/her pickup time.

Our current boarding rate is \$40.00/day for a stay of up to fourteen (14) consecutive days. We do not charge for the day of dropoff. If your dog needs boarding for a stay in excess of fourteen (14) consecutive days, we discount our daily rate as follows:

Stay up to thirty (30) days:	\$35.00/day	(12.5% off)
Stay longer than thirty (30) days:	\$30.00/day	(25% off)

If you are boarding two dogs with us simultaneously, the rates are as follows:

Stay up to fourteen (14) days:	\$65.00/day
Stay from fifteen (15) - thirty (30) days:	\$55.00/day
Stay longer than thirty (30) days:	\$45.00/day

We will provide you with an invoice for boarding and receipts for any extraordinary charges we incur on behalf of your dog (e.g., emergency veterinary care). Payment in full is expected at pickup. We accept cash, personal cheques, and electronic payments through PayPal, Zelle, or Venmo.

TEXAS H.B. 2063 REQUIRED NOTICE AND INFORMED CONSENT

In accordance with Texas law, we are required to notify you that from time to time we may leave your dog(s) confined in a crate without any humans at home. While it is very rare that Chuck and I are both absent from the premises simultaneously, it does occasionally happen during regular business hours (8 a.m. to 6 p.m.). We endeavour to leave dogs crated and unattended for as short a time as possible, and someone is ALWAYS home with the dogs throughout the night (at a minimum 10 p.m. – 8 a.m.).

Our home does NOT have a fire protection sprinkler system. We do have a security system which includes fire protection services.
