



MATHEMATICS

We often forget the number of times daily that mathematics touches our lives. From counting change, to balancing a checkbook, to keeping a household budget, to planning the cost for that “next” project, mathematics is a central part of our day-to-day lives. While the widespread use of technology makes life significantly easier, technology will only give us what we enter into it. Without a knowledge of mathematical concepts, this technology becomes useless. The central focus of the mathematics program at the Akron Education campus revolves around developing an understanding of math systems and processes, not just memorization of problems. This “real world” approach to math allows students to develop problem solving skills in addition to an understanding of the concepts required to solve these situations. Individual instruction allows us to adapt each program directly to the needs of the learner.

In addition to standard mathematics concepts, the Akron Education Campus also offers tutoring on an individual basis in Algebra, Geometry and higher level math courses.

To enroll in an individual program in math, contact or stop by the Akron Education Campus to schedule an initial interview/assessment session. Upon completion of this initial meeting, individual learning sessions will be scheduled. These sessions are typically 1/2 hour in length (although they can be scheduled for longer) and are usually scheduled for twice per week. As these are individual sessions; there is a great deal of flexibility in scheduling.
